## MESSAGE FROM THE WCA BOARD PRESIDENT

*Happy Valentine's Day!* Hope all of the Westport Community can celebrate a very special day with those they love.

This time of the year is important to the Westport Community Association Board. This is the time when we examine issues and ideas that we will deal with during the rest of our term and even beyond. Directions are charted, concepts are tested, accepted and rejected. Committees are formed and reports are written, read and acted upon.

We try, as best we can, to bring clear definition to what we want to do to strengthen our community and to insure that items significant to our membership are acted upon with all deliberate speed. We work to communicate what we are doing and what needs to be done to enhance the quality of life for all Westport residents. We realize that we are basically a social organization but even within that context, there is a lot that can and should be done.

This is also the time for membership renewals. Simply put, we need each and every Westport resident to join our association. It is voluntary, unlike most homeowner associations, and that is fine as far as we are concerned. Those of you that have already sent in your checks realize the importance of having a strong association. Those of you that have not yet decided to join are urged to do so "post haste." At this month's Board meeting, we heard from representatives of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office as they asked us for feedback on the formation of a newly funded Community Crimes Unit. They will be attending our monthly meetings and information will be shared on topics of mutual interest. (See article about this in the Community Watch section)

We are also being kept apprised regarding the situation with the Burton Creek project. Comm. Jim Klein and George Wood, County Manager, have both sent us information. When the time comes for input from the Westport community, we will be there.

We are also following the machinations of the Lake Norman Regional Bicycle Plan which calls for the use of certain Westport streets. Anyone who lives on or has driven upon Lakeshore Road South knows that additional traffic, vehicular or otherwise, is certainly not needed. We will continue to monitor this situation and speak out to let our feeling be known.

It is hard for any member of the Board to understand why residents would not wish to join the Association. The annual dues are minimal and clearly offset by the items you gain in return. For instance, only members will receive the next issue of the Westporter. That alone should be reason to join. I would be interested in hearing from any resident who has made the decision not to join. Let me know why - please!

Discussion has also begun with Robbie Smith, owner of the Club @ Westport regarding any possible bonding relationship between the WCA and his club. It is very exploratory at this stage and will take time to come to any understanding but interest seems to be there on both sides. We will keep you posted.

The last Board meeting also allowed us to discuss the staging of an event which will be new, exciting and different from anything held in the Westport community for some time. Anne Michaels is doing some heavy duty research and we may be able to discuss the specifics of this event with you very shortly. I am purposely being vague because not all of the details are in place. Members of the WCA will be the first to know. Another reason to join, not sometime in the future, but today.... this month.

Hope to see the sun a lot more in February. Again, have a great Valentine's Day and take good care of each other.

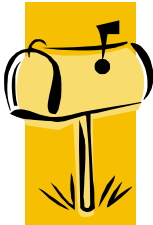
## COMMUNITY WATCH IN WESTPORT

From Mike McKenzie, Lincoln County Sheriff's Office: In the fall of 2009, the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office was awarded a \$900,000 grant to hire six new officers. This provided the sheriff's office the opportunity to enhance its community policing efforts. The sheriff's office is in the process of transitioning six experienced officers into a newly created Community Crimes Unit. This takes the philosophy of a community policing partnership building unit, and the philosophy of a crime suppression street crimes unit and combines it into one unit. This unit will have two primary functions. The first function is to serve as community coordinators for each of the three districts in Lincoln County and to serve as liaisons with the active community watch and neighborhood associations within the county. The second function will be to aggressively attack problem areas within the community by suppression and prevention style policing. These areas will be identified through citizen complaints, officer referrals, crime mapping, and other ways. In closing, this unit allows the sheriff's office to continue with its community policing efforts throughout the county. 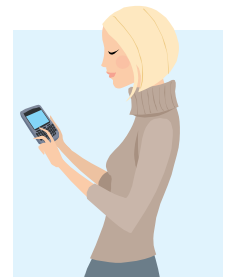
